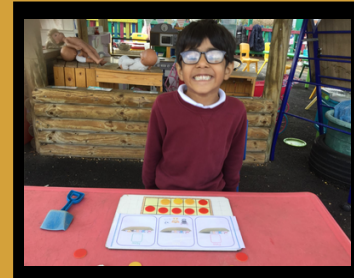

Ayaan for settling in beautifully in EYFS this week, his first week at Harrow Lodge.



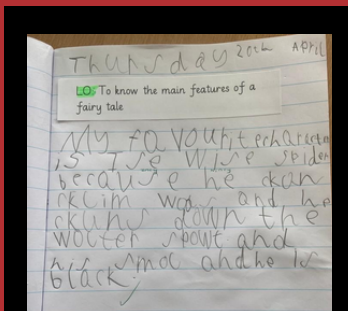
