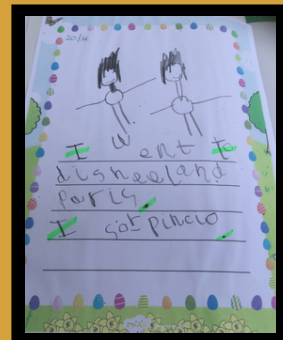

Alice G for taking care of our garden and for helping to plant carrot seeds.



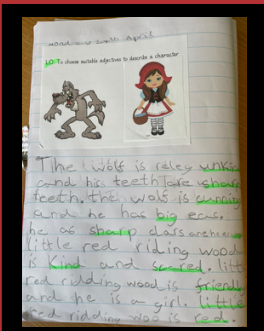

Alice D for her use of capital letters and full stops, when writing about her Easter holiday.



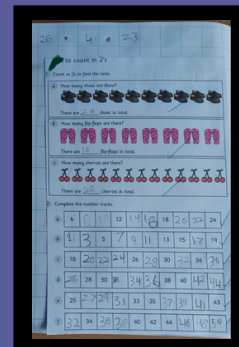

Mithran for choosing exciting adjectives to describe characters. Mithran always tries his best!



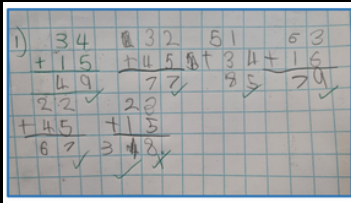

Diyan for confidently counting in 2's



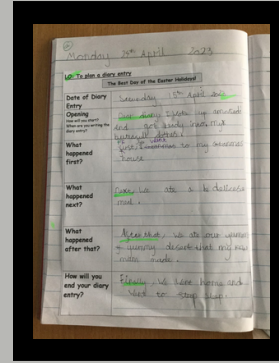

Summer for listening really well in maths and learning how to do column addition.



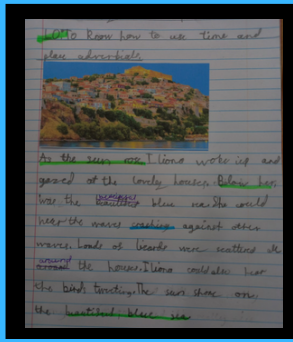

Aleeha for her use of time adverbials in her diary entry plan.



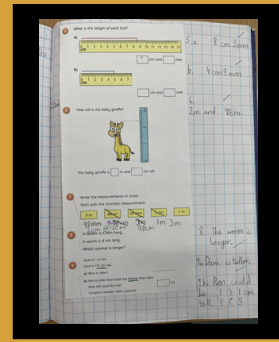

Joanna for a great setting description, using adverbials of time and place in English.



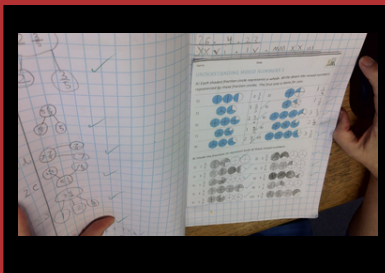

Daria, for working hard to read and compare measurements.



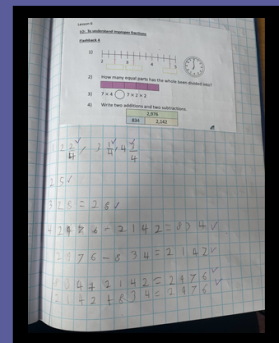

Olivia for her fantastic work on mixed fractions - great job!



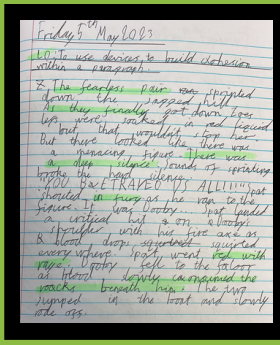

Michael, for always working hard in Maths and showing an excellent understanding of fraction.



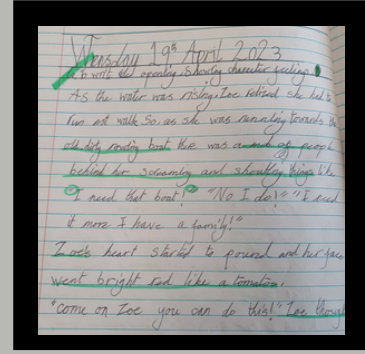

Freddie for working hard to improve his behaviour for learning which has resulted in an improvement in his work.



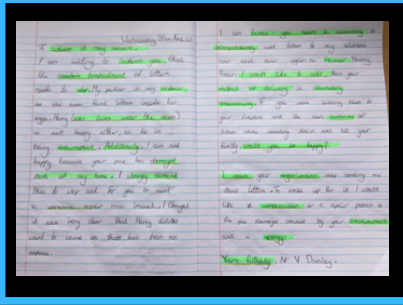

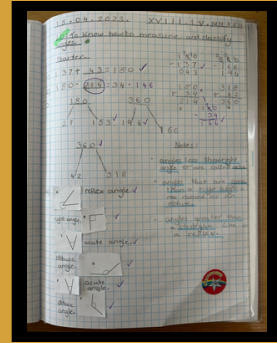
