

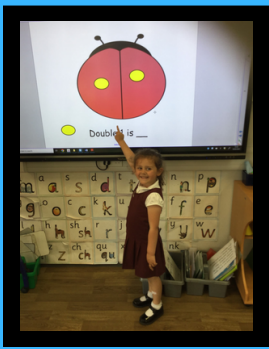

Albie for his understanding of how to use counters on a tens frame to represent the bottles on the wall. He could explain how many he needed to take away and how many were left.



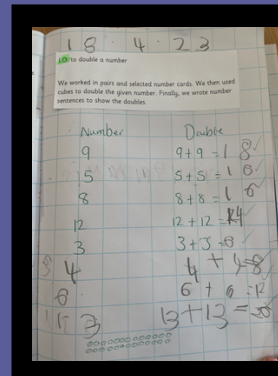

Zaydon for comparing Victorian and modern day schools. Well done!



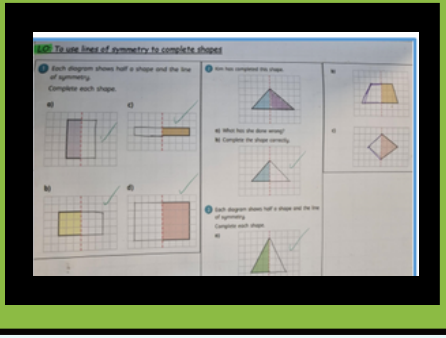

Teddy for correctly doubling numbers in his head.



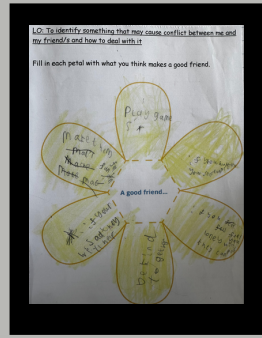

Isla for some excellent maths work on symmetry.



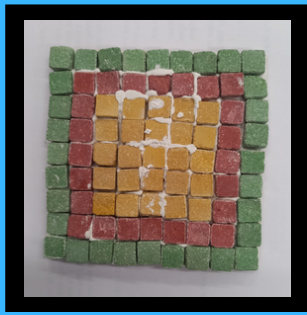

Mujtaba for independently creating a great mosaic tile.



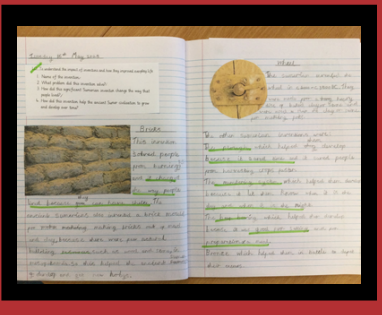

Jacob for his thorough research describing how inventions helped Sumerian Civilisation develop and grow in our history topic.



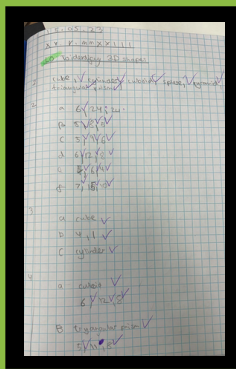

Zariana, for creating a beautiful Islamic pattern thinking carefully about the features she needed to include.



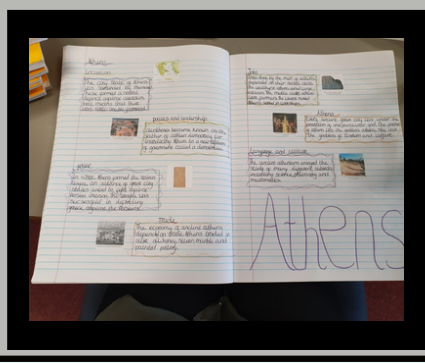

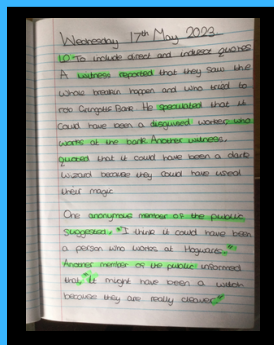

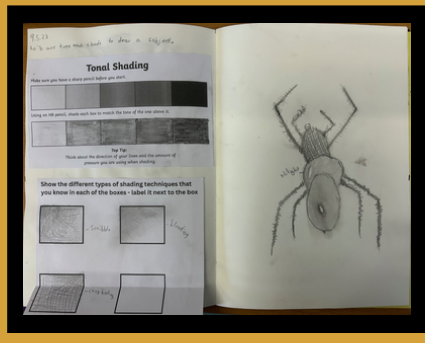
